### ➤ Important Dates and How to Enroll in Courses

#### ○ **Wednesday, August 3, after 6 p.m.: Enrichment Electives Week-at-a-Glance Preview posted on SYCAMORE**

- Read closely these Instructions, the Course Descriptions, and the Week-At-A-Glance; Review the offerings with your child(ren), then make 2 choices per period in order of preference (labeling as “1” and “2”). Note: See required courses to select (e.g., CONNECT, Study Skills); read about these on page 2. Accreditors wish to see students in a variety of classes, so avoid selecting multiple classes of the same type (e.g., P.E., art, music).

#### ○ **Monday, August 8, after 6 p.m.: Selection Sheets posted on Sycamore (DOCUMENTS tab| SCHEDULES folder)**

- For each child, download a Selection Sheet matching each child’s grade.
- Electronically fill in a separate Selection Sheet for each child showing Name, Grade, and Choices “1” and “2” for each period
- Promptly submit the completed Selection Sheet for each child using this method:

  - *Do not attempt to submit your form to any other e-mail address or personally to any staff member; as it cannot be accepted.*

- Courses are filled on a “first come, first served” basis with Seniors having enrollment priority.

- **Financial and Partnership accounts must be current!** Students with past due accounts (financial or Partnership hours) will not be logged into elective rosters until their family account is made current. Please contact the Admin Office if you have questions about your account (972-563-7227).

#### ○ **Friday, August 12, by noon: Selection Sheets due to avoid a \$50 late fee**

- ***Space in courses is limited.*** Courses are filled on a first-come, first-served basis, so please do not delay in returning your form (*e.g., 100+ received within 24 hours after Selection Sheets posted*). Earlier submission improves chances to get chosen courses. Preference to 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders in meeting necessary credits.
- Those courses with insufficient enrollment will be dropped; courses will be filled only to capacity (e.g., 10-18, depending upon course). Affected students will be moved to their next choice for that day/period.
- ***A \$50 Change Fee due for any change requested after your Selection Sheet is received in the PCCS office. No change requests accepted after August 26.***

- **High School Students, esp. Juniors and Seniors:** To determine what courses you need to graduate on time, refer to the Graduation Checklist reviewed during your College & Career consultations. ### ➤ How to read the Enrichment Elective Week-at-a-Glance:

- P-1st and 2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> graders take electives in the 7<sup>th</sup> period, while 4-6<sup>th</sup> graders take electives during the 6<sup>th</sup> period.
- 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> are scheduled for the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> periods, M-Th; abbreviations: JH = Junior High (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>) and HS = High School (9<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup>).
- The type of graduation credit appears 1<sup>st</sup> (see abbreviations on each page) followed by the course title, days offered, instructor name and room assignment.
- **Course surcharges** (“\*” on the schedule): PCCS offers a few courses taught by independent adjunct instructors (e.g., all Dance, Percussion) who charge higher rates (than for other PCCS courses) for which a surcharge is due to break even in those courses. Surcharges also apply to Tutoring\* (\$9-\$18 per session), Fast ForWord (M.-Th.+F. a.m.) (\$20/week for 5 days) to cover those costs as well as for special classes (e.g., Pottery-self-curing clay from Trinity Industries; Cooking-ingredient reimbursement to instructor; Leatherworking to cover cost of leather; after school instruction or clubs such as Karate Day 2)
- **Private Pay (“PP”):** Private music lessons (any period & after school) and after school private Tutoring\* are paid directly to the teacher--typically \$20/session.

2<sup>nd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Fast ForWord (M-Th+Fa.m.) (By referral of core teacher or admissions only; students struggling with language arts or reading are candidates for FF offered during the 7<sup>th</sup> period; see [www.scientificlearning.org](http://www.scientificlearning.org) for more information on this amazing program to retrain the temporal lobe/language center of the brain. *To cover FF costs, a surcharge of \$20/week applies*)

All grades, Assessment/Speech or Language Therapy (By referral only; for students needing assessment, speech or language therapy with PCCS diagnostician/speech & language therapist, Mrs. Broshous, MPB1. *Surcharge tbd by Therapist/Diagnostician*)

All grades, Tutoring\* (Students struggling with a core subject may enroll subject to approval; limit 2. *Tutoring\* surcharges are billed by the semester: \$162 for those in small groups of 2 or more and \$324 for one-on-one.*)

### PRIVATE CLASSES:

Private Guitar Lessons-All levels (Electric, acoustic and bass lessons, Beginners through Advanced, all styles; Days: Mon, Tues, Wed and Thurs, 6<sup>th</sup> period, 7<sup>th</sup> period and after school @ \$20/lesson for duo periods (or one-on-one lessons also available) paid

directly to the instructor, Mr. Igor Kudelin. He and his wife are returning this year from Ukraine. He is an instructor, a worship leader, musician who will help students gain skills & learn to play favorite songs)

**Private Piano Lessons-Beginner** (Music teacher, Katie Riley, offers beginning piano lessons to PCCS elementary students on T and Th; she will also lead the new worship band; lessons are \$20/each paid directly to the instructor)

**Private Piano Lessons-Beginner to Advanced** (Nataly Kudelin is returning this year to continue teaching beginner to advanced students; lessons are \$20/each paid directly to the instructor--or one-on-one lessons also available)

In this newly designed project-based C&C class, students will learn about Admissions, FAFSA, finding a degree plan, projected careers and salaries, tuition research, private vs. public/in-state vs. out-of-state, and "it's not like it used to, Mom and Dad," parking/transportation, book purchases/rentals/codes, online/online/online!, dining dollars, and more! Get this important graduation credit out of the way and be more prepared for your college & career planning; 1 fun field trip to match student availability; meets the HS C&C credit).

**COMP Keyboarding and Microsoft Word Basics NEW!** (In this skills development class, students learn to type correctly and faster as well as really understanding how Microsoft Word works)

**COMP Digital Signage I NEW!** (Students will use software to develop skills necessary to prepare, proof, edit and post digital signage on the school's new LCD hallway monitors; taught by our new computer instructor, Kathy Smith; meets .25 HS COMP credit)

**COMP Photography (DIGITAL CAMERA required to enroll)**; students will learn the principles behind good photography and practice skills including editing with Photoshop)

**COMP Presentations NEW!** (Work with Powerpoint and Prezi and prepare concise and effective presentations--a college-prep skill; meets .25 HS COMP credit)

**COMP Stop Motion Animation: Stickybones NEW!** (Using new animation figures called Stickybones, students will create animated videos for posting and competing at TCAL; meets .25 HS COMP credit) \$25 supplies surcharge applies.

**Creative Writing NEW!** (Learn more about creative writing, practice skills, and learn about how to publish stories)

**Cub Scout Packs! NEW!** (Elementary boys in grades 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> have an opportunity to meet during electives slots! **Parent leaders needed; Den Chiefs needed—Boys Scouts & Eagle Scouts, please apply!** PAN Julie Cato, the PCCS Scouting Coordinator)

**Emergency Response Workshop NEW!** (Learn from a former EMT how to respond to various emergencies)

**Exam Prep (Math or English, TSI/ACT/SAT/PSAT)** (Practice and review writing and language arts or math skills needed for college entrance exams; 10<sup>th</sup> graders and up; *meets HS graduation requirement*)

**FA Collages & Mosaics NEW!** (Student will make various art projects that involve designing collages and mosaics throughout the semester)

**FA Concentangle: Wall Murals NEW!** (Prerequisite: Concentangle or preapproved by Instructor Larson; a popular course for creating intricate pen and ink creations on the MPB Wall of Fame; *meets .25 HS Fine Art credit*)

**FA Handmade Creations NEW!** (Students will learn to make quilted totes, purses, pillows as time permits)

**FA Project Linus NEW!** (Join "blanketeers" from around the nation to make and donate blankets through Project Linus to children who are seriously ill, traumatized, or otherwise in need; for more information: <https://www.projectlinus.org/about/>)

**FA Music: PCCS Worship Band I NEW!** (a new band is forming under new music teacher, Ms. Riley (this is not the student-led "Poetry in Motion" band); by audition only; seeking a drummer, guitar players, keyboardist, and vocalists; meets .25 HS Fine Arts credit per semester; \$10/week instructor & maintenance surcharge applies.)

**Health, Safety & Manners** (This fun and useful ABEKA curriculum offers instruction and practice in learning how to be healthy, safe and mannerly!)

**Home Ec\* Spice of the Week** (Students learn about different spices as well as how to cook with them) \$25 supplies surcharge applies.

**HONORS English: Short Works by Favorite Authors NEW!** (Students will read and discuss short works by Flannery O'Connor, C.S. Lewis-The Great Divorce, Eric Liddell-Chariots of Fire movie, Dietrich Bonhoeffer-Letters & Papers from Prison; must have 80%+ average to gain credit; weighted grade)

**HONORS COMP Yearbook Team:** (By invitation only-if not formerly in the class, must apply to Mrs. Phillips and demonstrate strong computer skills, digital photography, and creativity; class size limited; students will work the online Yearbook program to brainstorm and work on the current year's yearbook in this creative class; must have 80%+ average to gain credit; weighted grade; meets .25 HS COMP credit)

**HONORS/DUAL CREDIT Psychology** (Student gain college credit in this interesting course required for most college majors and transferrable to most colleges)

**Modern Electronics NEW!** (Electronic devices affects virtually every area of our lives—everything from electricity to amplifiers to circuits to analog & digital devices; students watch segments in this video series and participate in the class discussion group)

**Money Management for Teens, Dave Ramsey** (In this Dave Ramsey curriculum, teens learn about budgeting, personal finance, interest, taxes, credit cards, and fiscal management. Meets Graduation Credit for Money Mgt/Consumer Math)

**PE Archery I and Archery II** (In Archery I, students gain the basic archery and related safety skills of the National Archery in School Program; in Archery II, students from Archery I who are ready for competition and have their own bow will have a chance to compete often) The school has one left and one right bow to use during class for students without bow; students in Archery I should and in Archery II must have their own *competition-level Genesis compound bow of less than 20 lbs.—Walmart carries these for \$150...WALMART.COM information: "Genesis Original Bow, Model 12234, choose left or right handed, Walmart #553242036"*

**PE Ballroom Dance Performance: NEW!** Students will work together to form three performance routines: Foxtrot, Waltz, and Tango. Wed 7<sup>th</sup> period, 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>

**PE Boys'/Girls' JH, JV and Varsity Team Athletics (NEW! ATHLETICS CLASSES ARE NOW A FULL SEMESTER; IF ATHLETE DOES NOT CHOOSE THE NEXT SEASON'S SPORT, HE/SHE WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO AN ATHLETICS CONDITIONING CLASS—STUDY HALL NOT PERMITTED):** P.E. slots will work on skills and formal practices begin with the season (Volleyball-August; Basketball-November as per league rules) with after school practices required at that time; game schedules are posted on Sycamore, right sidebar, and on the CALENDAR tab; meets .5 HS PE credit)

**PE Country Western Two Step NEW!** (Students will be taught the three most popular two step dances: Texas Two Step, Progressive Two Step and Night Club Two Step, Wed 6<sup>th</sup> period 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>; meets .25 HS PE credit)

**PE Credit Alternatives for High Schoolers (Option 1-PE credit will be given for students who enroll in Poetry Fitness classes held in the MPB evenings, see current schedule, must pay by the semester, school attendance policy applies; .25 credits for one class attended weekly; may attend multiple classes per week to gain credits, e.g. 2 classes/week = .5 credits) (Option 2-Students may apply for PE-Equivalent credit for competition sports outside of the PCCS schedule subject to certain requirements; see the College & Career Counselor for details)**

**PE Get Fit Boot Camp** (A healthy PE elective to gain strength and stamina; taught by a certified fitness instructor; workout clothes & athletic shoes required; an optional 5K ends the semester; meets .25 HS PE credit; no prerequisite required)

**PE Fitness Fun** (Elementary students get fit playing in soccer & kickball for great cardio!)

**PE Holy Yoga** (Anyone who has taken this class knows it isn't an easy PE credit but will build strength through isometrics and weights as well as flexibility--all to contemporary Christian music; taught by a certified Holy Yoga instructor; comfortable workout clothes permitting movement required/NO JEANS; Gain a .25 HS Graduation Checklist PE credit)

**PE Karate –Christian Soldiers, White to Black Belts** (Belt class designates what student is at the beginning of the semester; choose the course matching student belt level (e.g., white belt = beginners). A nationally-recognized program requires Bible memory & Christian character for belt testing; CS karate uniform required). *After-school sessions are a required part of this program in order to adequately prepare for belt testing; a*

*semester surcharge of \$80 will be invoiced; The Belt Testing fee of \$35 due at end of semester to instructors.*

**PE Power Walking NEW!** (Students will learn to move from a casual stroll to an athletic gait and pace that doctors endorse and studies support!)

**PE Social Dance & Etiquette NEW!** (Students will learn social graces and dance manners while they are introduced to the graceful Waltz, carefree Foxtrot and a few social line dances. Tues 6<sup>th</sup> period, 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>)

**PE Swing Time NEW!** (Students will learn a variety of swing dances including: East Coast, West Coast and Hustle. Swing dancing can be done to Country, Oldies, Disco and Pop music. Tues, 7<sup>th</sup> period 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>)

**PE Weights and Conditioning NEW! (ATHLETES ONLY;** class size limited; fully develop your strength and stamina to perform better in athletics; taught by former coach)

**Scripture & Song NEW!** (Practical application of God's word is a valuable lifelong skill; class uses video illustrations to show relevance of scripture in a child's world while they learn & sing scripture songs from Steve Green's Hide 'em in your Heart DVDs; these, along with brief drama, may be presented by the electives class during chapel services).

**Show-N-Tell NEW!** (Even younger students get an opportunity to develop their presentation skills in this fun class)

**Signing to Songs NEW!** (Students learn basic sign language to interpret praise songs; they will present for Chapel later in the semester)

**Social Issues and Election Discussion Group NEW!** (In this roundtable format, students research and discuss key social issues affecting America today and how those issues are being handled in the campaigns for the upcoming election)

**Speech & Communications NEW!** (As per the new TEA guidelines, PCCS is offering HS students the Speech & Communications credit to meet their graduation requirement)

**Stock Market Challenge** (Students are challenged to "play the stock market" through this simulation class; may include buy/sell penny stocks)

**Storywriting NEW!** (Do you like to write? Do you have ideas that are just waiting to bring to life? Students write and edit stories and learn about publishing options and competitions; taught by a published and awarded young adult writer & PCCS Alum)

**Study Hall-Proctored** (Space limited; must work on homework or quietly read to remain in class; no sleeping or departing campus during this period)

**Tourist Spanish** (Students gain "travel" knowledge and basic conversational skills in these oral Spanish class; also meets .25 LL alternative foreign language credit)

**Very Cool Stories NEW!** (Through stories told by Jesus, students learn eternal truths that Jesus revealed in them...they will meet a lost and found son, a rich fool, disgruntled vineyard workers, a good Samaritan, and many other memorable characters; includes activities and crafts)

**Weaving** (A popular spring semester offering is back; students learn to create various projects using weaving skills for possible competition in the TCAL meet; class; meets .25 HS FA credit)

**What Would Jesus Post?** (Students learn to use wisdom in using social media—both how to represent themselves well as Christians and how to avoid damaging their reputations and stay safe on social media)
