MIDDLE SCHOOL REQUIRED COURSES:

Algebra Practicum for Rosenbaum Algebra students: All students in Mrs. Rosenbaum's Algebra I course are required to select one Algebra Practicum as an extension of studies undertaken during the Monday-Thursday core class periods.

Digital Awareness: What Would Jesus Post?: 6th-9th graders who have not already had this course at PCCS.

Study Skills & Organization: 7th-9th graders who have not already had this course at PCCS.

SPECIAL SERVICES, BY REFERRAL ONLY:

All grades, Tutoring*: Students struggling with a core subject may enroll subject to approval; limit 2. *Tutoring* surcharges are billed lump sum by the semester: FALL Semester - \$180 for those in groups of 2 or more and \$360 for one-on-one.*

Be A Scientist! NEW! This indoor and outdoor class introduces neat science observations, experiments, and activities in the Science Porch.

CCB Christian Character Trait of the Week

CCB Mission Minded Missions involve much more than departing, working, and returning from the mission field; it begins with being Mission Minded; learn how to become so as PCCS Mission Team leaders help students prepare for upcoming Mission Trips.

CCB Praise Songs Joy, joy, joy comes through music, as students sing favorites and learn new praise and worship songs.

CTE Adulting Skills 101 NEW! Young adults are increasingly leaving home for college or other pursuits without the skills most seasoned adults take for granted. In this class, a wide variety of skills, at least one per week, are introduced to live and function more independently (and even help more around the household!)

COMM Speech I Speech I and II can be taken in any order; practice speaking and performance skills to prep for performance either on campus or in ACSI / TCAF competitions; meets Speech 1 Graduation Checklist requirement.

Exam Prep (Math & English, TSI/ACT/SAT/PSAT) Practice the skills needed for college entrance exams; 10th graders and up; *meets HS graduation requirement*

Exotic Animals NEW! Everyone knows about farm animals, dogs, and cats. What about the unusual animals that are not in Texas or even the USA? Learn about exotic animals you can keep at home, how to care for them, and where they are found in the world. Discuss why some exotic animals are better in the wild than at home. Learn about the difference between animals in several different countries. Choose your favorites! Possible volunteer trip at a wildlife rescue or exotic animal rescue (TBD). This class is for those who love animals and want to learn more about God's animal kingdom.

FA Calendar Art The calendar will guide the art projects chosen for this fun and crafty class!

In this creative writing class, students will not only be getting tips of the trade from a published novelist, Mrs. Shook, but also practice writing creatively through writing games, unique prompts and learning to be a ferocious editor of their own work.

FA Recorder Band I NEW! Join Mr. DaSilva (aka Mr. Wilson) in learning the Soprano Recorder instrument as well as Music Theory (which includes reading the music notes). The Soprano Recorder is the most affordable and the easiest instrument to introduce your child to the world of music. *NOTE 2 options: 1) Purchase your own "Soprano Recorder-German Model" (not Baroque) OR 2) purchase one to keep from PCCS for \$10—bring first day of class.*

FA Scrapbooking NEW! Join

FA Theatre—One Act for Elementary: "A Very Winter Fairy Tale" Cast & Crew NEW! Lots of prep and rehearsals are required to be ready for this December performance! Some Friday after school practices required two weeks prior to Performances (click on NOTES for details); (\$25 costume fee if costume provided by PCCS).

FA Theatre Sets and Design Join Stage Creative Director, Mrs. Brown, to envision, develop, design, paint, and create sets for this semester's Elementary One-Act production.

FA Trash to Treasure NEW! Do you wish to explore the idea of taking items that are considered trash and by rebuilding, reconstructing, and remaking those items turning them into usable and marketable products? The class goal is to take things destined for landfill (found at our own homes or thrift stores) and give them new life. FL Spanish Fun / Travel Spanish NEW! A new instructor, Mr. DaSilva (aka Mr. Wilson), offers a fun oral Spanish class as if you were walking through a Spanish-speaking country and needed basic Spanish skills

Health I HS students are required to take Health to graduate; meets Graduation Checklist requirement.

HONORS ENG – Intro to the Short Story NEW! Students enjoy an introduction to the short story, its history and development through reading and discussion major representatives of the genre including Hawthorne, Poe, Melville, Gogol, Tolstoy, Chekhov, DeMaupassant, Hardy, James, Conrad, Mansfield, Anderson, Faulkner, Flannery O'Connor, Frank O'Connor, and Singer; must have 80%+ average to gain credit; weighted grade.

HONORS SCIENCE/RELIGION: Creation & Truth vs. Evolution-NEW! (no prerequisite ; course updated from 2021-22) Why does it matter that students believe that the God of the Bible is the Creator of the universe as opposed to "Something came from Nothing" which Evolution teaches? Are the 1st 11 chapters of Genesis myth? Jesus believed in Adam and Eve. How does disbelief in Genesis affect the Gospel? "After 4 yrs. of college, as high as 59% of students no longer describe themselves as "born again. That's a fallout rate of almost two-thirds!" The reason many lose their faith is due largely to the pervasiveness of evolutionary thinking. The so called fact of evolution affects one's biblical worldview. Is this "science falsely so called (1 Tim. 6:20)" taking our youth captive? Take this opportunity to explore both sides of this issue. Must have 80%+ average to gain credit; weighted grade.

HONORS TECH Yearbook/Instagram Team: Students from last semester have enrollment priority and use computer skills, digital photography, and personal creativity to complete this year's Yearbook using an online app; requires outside class time to meet deadlines; must have 80%+ average to gain credit; weighted grade; meets .25 HS COMP credit.

Lit Circle: Chosen NEW! If you love reading and great fantasy, this is the literary circle for you. Ted Dekker's *Chosen* follows the story of four teenagers in the Forest Guard who are chosen to lead a special mission against the evil threatening the world. These four must find the Books of History before the Dark One gets them first! This fantasy series is for those seeking a new Christian-allegory that is clean, fun, and exciting. Our literary circle will not only read and discuss *Chosen* but also consider how its themes are applicable today. Join us for the *Chosen* Literary Circle!

Money Management for Teens, Dave Ramsey In this Dave Ramsey curriculum, teens learn about budgeting, personal finance, interest, taxes, credit cards, and fiscal management. Meets Graduation Credit for Money Mgt/Consumer Math; offered each semester with Mr. Risinger.

NASA Then & Now NEW! Students explore and learn about NASA's roots as well as the amazing accomplishments since then; interesting projects are guided by the NASA curriculum.

PE Archery - Beginning and Intermediate Bryan Goodwin continues as instructor to teach archery skills, safety, and competition skills for the team class under the guidelines of our school's membership in the National Archery in Schools Program (NASP); school-owned bows are available or students may inquire as to what bow may be used after the first day of class.

PE Elementary Co-ed Ball Team NEW! Led by Coach Cheney to learn the rules and basics of playing basketball; we will seek competition opportunities with Lake Pointe sports or the YMCA (please PAN Coach Cheney if you have information on this).

PE Boys'/Girls' JH, JV and Varsity Team Athletics Players work on skills first until the formal season begins (Volleyball-August; Basketball-November; Baseball/Softball-Feb/March as per league rules) with after-school practices required at that time. For basketball team, the class is required in during the Fall &

FALL semesters (no new students may join in the FALL semester). Those interested in only Varsity Baseball or Softball should select the 7th period P.E. class for that sport; Game schedules are posted on Sycamore, right sidebar, and on the CALENDAR tab; meets .5 HS PE credit.

PE Fitness Fun, Guided physical fitness activities will offer students a way to expel extra energy as well as improve gross motor skills and even thinking skills!

PE Karate –Christian Soldiers, White to Black Belts* Choose the belt class that matches the student's belt level at the start of a semester (e.g., white belt = beginners). This nationally recognized program requires Bible memory & Christian character for belt testing; CS karate uniform required. *After-school sessions required for some belts to adequately prepare for belt testing; a semester instructor pass-thru surcharge of \$5/week billed by the semester; for those students who Belt Test, the CS Belt Testing fee is \$35.*

PE Christian Zumba (Girls only) NEW! This class includes a short devotion, healthy tips and then dance away the stress while praising the Lord with Refitrev.com Christian Zumba

Science Porch Management A favorite returns! Assist Mrs. Cato with Science Porch organization, housekeeping, animal care, and overall management.

Study Hall-Proctored Must work on homework or quietly read to remain in class; four school computers are available in the Lewis Room where this is scheduled; responsible use of laptops may be permitted on a case-by-case basis (see school's Internet Policy in all cases including no instant messaging or recreational media); *sleeping or not staying academically busy will result in referral to the campus cleanup team.*

TECH Excel I NEW! In this tech-based course, students the basics of Excel, a important skill for life after high school including college and business.

TECH Minecraft NEW! Students will learn simple javascript commands to make Mods; learn how to use pressure plates, complete a circuit using redstone, and so much more! *Surcharge of \$25 to cover licensing fees.*

TECH TechnoMe – Coding Skills Step-by-step, younger students learn computer skills in this fun biographical computer class where they share fun facts, goals, interests and more about themselves.

TECH TechnoToon – Coding Skills Create a graphic story that looks like a cartoon or animated comic strip using Google Slides or PowerPoint. Integrate creative writing with technology using digital storytelling lessons.

Teen Talk NEW! Explore how you think, how you manage stress, how the mind works to solve problems or sabotage your day, how to set better goals and more; uses an experience teacher and curriculum for teens to guide this circle time where teens can learn healthier ways to manage day to day, set goals, manage time, think in healthier ways, and manage relationships more successfully.
