Dear Parents: Please read **all** of the following instructions carefully. **Blue highlight=Updates**

➤ Important Dates and How to Enroll in Courses

- **Thursday, December 6, after 7 p.m.: Enrichment Electives Week-at-a-Glance Preview posted on SYCAMORE**
 - Read closely these Instructions, Course Descriptions, and the Week-At-A-Glance; Review offerings with your child(ren) & make 2 choices per period in order of preference (labeling as “1” and “2”). Note: See required courses to select (e.g., CONNECT, Study Skills); read about these on the Course Descriptions page. Accreditors wish to see students in a variety of classes, so avoid selecting multiple classes of the same type (e.g., P.E., art, music).
- **Monday, December 10 after 7 p.m.: Selection Sheets posted on Sycamore (DOCUMENTS tab| SCHEDULES folder)**
 - For each child, download a Selection Sheet matching each child’s grade.
 - Electronically fill in a separate Selection Sheet for each child showing Name, Grade, and Choices “1” and “2” for each period
 - Promptly submit the completed Selection Sheet for each child using this method:

 - *Do not attempt to submit your form to any other e-mail address or personally to any staff member; as it cannot be accepted.*
 - Courses are filled on a “first come, first served” basis with Seniors having enrollment priority.
 - **Financial and Partnership accounts must be current!** Students with past due accounts (financial or Partnership hours) will not be logged into elective rosters until their family account is made current. Please contact the Admin Office if you have questions about your account (972-563-7227).
- **Thursday, December 13 by 8:30 p.m.: Selection Sheets due to avoid a \$50 late fee**
- **Space in courses is limited, and courses are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.** Please do not delay in returning your form (e.g., 100+ received within 24 hours after Selection Sheets posted). Earlier submission improves chances to get chosen courses. Preference to 11th-12th graders in meeting necessary credits.
- Courses will be filled to scheduled capacity; those with insufficient enrollment will be dropped. Affected schedules are adjusted to next choice for that day/period. Note: Athletes on teams will not be scheduled for alternative P.E. electives that are reserved for non-team students needing P.E. credits.
- **A \$50 Change Fee due for any change requested after your Selection Sheet is received in the PCCS office. No change requests accepted after January 11.**
- **High School Students, esp. Juniors and Seniors:** To determine what courses you need to graduate on time, refer to the Graduation Checklist reviewed during your College & Career consultations. If you need a copy of this or have questions, contact the PCCS College & Career Counselor, Mrs. Nelson, at her e-mail: CandC@poetrychristian.org. Blank Graduation Checklists are loaded on Sycamore at the Documents|C&C tab.
- **How to read the Enrichment Elective Week-at-a-Glance:**
 - Elementary Electives M-Th class periods: Primer and 1st graders - 1st period; 2nd-3rd graders – 7th period; 4-6th graders - 6th period.
 - 7th – 12th are scheduled for M-Th 6th and 7th periods; abbreviations: JH = Junior High (7th & 8th) and HS = High School (9th -12th).
 - The type of graduation credit appears 1st (see abbreviations on each page) followed by the course title, days offered, instructor name and room assignment.
 - **Course surcharges (“*” on the schedule):** PCCS offers a few courses taught by independent adjunct instructors (e.g., all Dance, Percussion) who charge higher rates (than for other PCCS courses) for which a surcharge is due to break even in those courses. Surcharges also apply to Tutoring* (\$9-\$18 per session), Fast ForWord (M.-Th.+F. a.m. @ \$20/week for 5 days) to cover those costs. Other surcharges apply for special classes (e.g., Pottery-self-curing clay from Trinity Industries; Cooking-ingredient instructor reimbursement e.g. \$25; Praise/Worship Teams \$10/wk; Leatherworking to cover cost of leather; after school instruction or clubs such as Karate Day 2, e.g. \$5/wk)
 - Private Pay (“PP”): Private music lessons (any period & after school) and after school private Tutoring* are paid directly to the teacher--typically \$20/session.

Enrichment Course Descriptions

REQUIRED ENRICHMENT COURSES:

7th – 12th Grades CONNECT classes CONNECT classes use different multi-denominational curricula each semester (primarily from www.cbd.com). CONNECT teachers include Pastor Michael Moonoo, Pastor Kevin Kelley, Brian Risinger, Bryan Packard, Vickie Gilmore, Kim Pierrotti, Dallas McNeal, Holli Kenney, Suzanne Phillips, and Pastor Brandon McGowin).

STUDENTS MUST PICK ANY COMBINATION OF 2 CONNECTS PER SEMESTER:

CONNECT A (Apologetics): Apologetic classes will be discussion-based with a teacher facilitator to engage in common questions that youth have about the Bible, the culture around us, and how to grow in faith in spite of non-Christian influences. This semester's selections include: *I Am N: Inspiring Stories of Christians Facing Islamic Extremists* (<https://www.amazon.com/Am-Inspiring-Stories-Christians-Extremists/dp/1434709876>); *Tru-U: Does God Exist* (<https://www.amazon.com/Does-God-Exist-Building-Scientific/dp/1589973399>), *Truth Unplugged* (<https://www.amazon.com/Truth-Unplugged-David-C-Cook/dp/B0099JIW4Y>)

CONNECT B (Bible): Bible classes will be surveys of the Old Testament, New Testament, or particular themes or Books of the Bible to reinforce basic Bible knowledge as the foundation of our faith. *Some New Highlights:* *The Book of Ruth* (Walk the journey of Ruth, Naomi, and Boaz and discover the devoted love of God and His transformative power in our lives), *Old Testament Turning Points, The Life of Christ*

CONNECT C (Community Service: Missions & Children/Local Ministry) This course will focus on ministry to children's Chapel and the local community (e.g. nursing homes). Those high school students interested in attending the Mission Trip in June must sign up for the Missions class in the spring semester. The Children's Ministry group will learn how to teach the Gospel to younger kids. In this class, you will learn how to speak about Jesus to others and teaching the Bible in a way that speaks especially to children and those who are musically inclined will work on music ministry. Students will form up in teams to help teach many of the Elementary Chapels (with help from Mrs. Moonoo); the Missions Team will be going on the June Mission Trip.

CONNECT D (Discipleship): Discipleship classes will focus on how to help students develop their faith...how they live it out in their lives now and in the future as they leave home and PCCS. *Some New Highlights:* *Parables for Guys, A Young Woman After God's Own Heart* by Elizabeth George; *Think: Nail What You Believe & Why* (<https://www.christianbook.com/think-nail-what-believe-and-why/kevin-johnson/9780310282662/pd/282662>); *Make Every Day Count* (Teen Edition) by Max Lucado.

SPECIAL SERVICES, BY REFERRAL ONLY:

2nd-12th Fast ForWord (M-Th+Fa.m.) (By referral only; now in the core program for students struggling reading and language arts; see www.scientificlearning.org for more info on this

amazing program to retrain the temporal lobe/language center of the brain. **To cover FF costs, a surcharge of \$20/week applies**)

All grades, Tutoring* (Students struggling with a core subject may enroll subject to approval; limit 2. **Tutoring* surcharges are billed lump sum by the semester:** \$162 for those in small groups of 2 or more and \$324 for one-on-one).

PRIVATE CLASSES:

Private Guitar Lessons*-All levels-Tuesdays and Thursdays only (Electric, acoustic, ukulele & bass lessons, Beginners thru Advanced, all styles; Days: **Tuesdays and Thursdays only, 6th and 7th periods and after school** @ \$20/lesson for duo periods (or one-on-one lessons full period lessons @ \$40) paid directly to instructor, Igor Kudelin. He is an instructor, a worship leader at The Vale Church, and musician who helps students gain skills & learn to play favorite songs)

Private Piano Lessons*-Beginner (Primer and 1st) (New music instructor, Marisa Frankum, offers beginning piano during our 1st period to Primer and 1st graders! The curriculum is Faber "My First Piano Adventure for the Young Beginner," and lessons are \$20/each paid directly to the instructor)

Private Piano & Trombone Lessons*-Beginner/Intermediate (New music instructor, Heather D. Meister, offers beginning and intermediate piano and trombone lessons to PCCS 2nd-12th students during the 6th, 7th and after school periods; lessons are \$20/each paid directly to the instructor)

Private Piano Lessons*-Beginner to Advanced (Mondays-Thursdays) (Nataly Kudelin, Doctorate in Piano, teaches beginner to advanced students; Days: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday 6th and 7th & 7th period and after school. \$20/each ½ period lesson paid directly to the instructor--or individual lessons available)

Private Drum or Guitar Lessons (Mondays only) (Marshall Hoybook, adjunct music instructor, has experience in public school as well as worship team leadership and will teach on Mondays 6th and 7th for Drumline and after school Mondays for group or individual lessons. \$20 each ½ period lesson paid directly to the instructor; \$20 for group; \$40 for one-on-one lessons).

REGULAR ENRICHMENT COURSES (alphabetically):

Art-Painting with a Juice Box (Primer and 1st grade students enjoy learning how to paint in a new way...with a juice box on canvas!)

Art-Fingerpainting **NEW!** (Primer and 1st grade students will prepare a calendar with art for each month)

Bible Trait of the Week II (In the Sycamore scrolling sidebar, the Christian Character Trait of the Week is listed for each semester; this class will explore the weekly Trait of the week with Bible stories and activities)

Bugs & Butterflies **NEW!** (This is just a fun name for ENTOMOLOGY! from Ancient Greek έντομον (entomon), meaning 'insect', and -λογία (-logia), meaning 'study of')—but at PCCS, this will be the FUN and SCIENTIFIC study of bugs and butterflies!

Chess Challenge* (PCCS continues its partnership with Sunny Chess Company to offer school chess programs and opportunities for competition nationwide; students will receive Zoom instruction from Sunny instructors, interact via computers with class team members, and develop skills toward competing in future competitions with other students) **NOTE: Students**

must bring personal earphones/ear buds each week AND pay a semester pass-surcharge \$30/student pass-thru instructor fee applies

Co-ed Dance* (Primer and 1st grade boys and girls have fun learning and improving dance skills in their 1st period electives this year; performance planned at end of semester **NO JEANS; proper P.E. Attire required/see Dress Code and teacher-required dance shoes**

College & Career: Learn about college types, financial options for college costs, aptitudes, majors and degree plans, votech, and other exploration projects; meets Graduation Checklist requirement) **10th grade Spring, Juniors or Seniors may take this course.**

COMM Speech Team (Students practice speaking skills and preliminary prep for spring tournaments (ACSI/here; TCAL/San Antonio Speech Meets; meets Graduation Checklist requirement)

Collage-A-Week **NEW!** (New this semester but a past favorite, Collage-A-Week enables students to work with various items each week to create artistic creations)

Co-Ed Cub Scout Packs* (Come one, come all! https://scoutingwire.org/marketing-and-membership-hub/bsa-today/?utm_source=AC&utm_medium=email&utm_content=BSAtoday7262019

Scouts will spend class time working on their den requirements while having fun! Once per month, there is a required Pack meeting after school and other after school activities/meetings planned. PARENTS: Please attend the mandatory parent meeting scheduled at the beginning of the semester. If you are looking for Parent Partnership hours, be a den leader and enjoy spending quality time with child! Come join the adventurous world of scouting! **There is a \$34 annual registration fee with the national organization which including yearly membership and Scout Magazine) plus a student-purchased uniform/rank appropriate scout shirt is required** (look on eBay etc. used). **Parent leaders needed;** PAN Julie Cato, the PCCS Scouting Coordinator)

ECON Stock Market Game **UPDATED!** (This curriculum, <https://www.stockmarketgame.org/expteacher.html>, effectively contextualizes the academic content standards, practices, and career skills expressed in the CCSS, STEM, and by the Partnership for 21st Century Skills where students methodically learn and practice interdisciplinary skills necessary to understand and work with the stock market)

Etiquette for our Times **NEW!** (Manners are not passe'. In fact, there are even more ways we should be considering our manners, including with cell phones; this class will discover and review and practice manners for current times from such resources as:

Exam Prep (Math & English, TSI/ACT/SAT/PSAT) **UPDATED!** (Practice English or math skills needed for college entrance exams; 10th graders and up; *meets HS graduation requirement*) **NOTE: Students must bring personal earphones/ear buds each week**

FA Bible Journaling* (Bring your Journal Bibles and pens/pencils; Learn Bible concepts and values as well as techniques for representing faith through artistic flares and key words and phrases as well as prayers/praises) **Students must bring their own Journaling Bible and Bible-safe markers/pencils.**

FA Painting with a Twist **NEW!** (If you like to paint or want to learn how, join this new painting class with new art instructor, Amy Weber, who formerly worked at PWAT).

FA Papercrafting **NEW!** (Learn how to make greeting cards and decorate a journal and clipboard. Students will learn how to heat emboss and use a die cutting machine)

FA Concentangle: Wall Murals III (LET'S FINISH THAT WALL! Prerequisite: Concentangle or preapproved by Instructor KTownsend; a popular course for creating and finishing intricate pen and ink creations on the MPB Wall of Fame; *meets .25 HS Fine Art credit*)

FA Drumline*(Students learn basic percussion skills, reading music, and counting on the snare and other various percussion instruments to develop toward musicianship on the beginning Drumline; meets .25 HS Fine Arts credit); **\$5/week instructor/equipment/maintenance surcharge applies.**

FA & LEADERSHIP Chapel Teams* (Students will seek out Chapel programs and speakers and periodically offer music for Chapel)

FA Painting with a Twist **NEW!** (Join new art instructor for this fun class based upon her former job at PWAT!)

FA Pen Art **NEW!** (With the current interest in calligraphy, we just had to bring in an instructor to teach the basics of beautiful pen art!)

FA Stained Glass* (A favorite returns! Students learn the basics of creating small stained glass creations with a cross as their first project; time-permitting, students will make a stained glass gift for the mission team host in Kentucky) **\$25 content supplies surcharge applies.**

FA Theatre The Sneaky Citizens of Saddleore City* **NEW!** (Cast & Crew assigned via December auditions; students will memorize lines over Christmas Break (script posted on Sycamore NEWS) and be "off book" when they return in January; in-school practices on Wednesdays 6th and 7th periods; after school Fridays begin in March by Acts only (so not all students will be required to be there); Daily afterschool rehearsals the two weeks before the play by Act with Dress and Video full rehearsals the week before the performances the first weekend in April; **meets .5 HS Fine Arts or .5 Comm/Speech credit** PLUS 100 points toward HS Letter) *Costume fee due or costumes provided by actors determined in January by Mrs. Kenney, Asst. Director.*

FA Wood Artistry II (Students learn calligraphy and painting to create beautiful wood blocks with names, inspirational words, and designs)

FL American Sign Language I and II (These two classes give beginners two options: Learn for the first time or continue to work on ASL skills with our ASL Instructor; meets electives credit as well as graduation requirement for SG students)

FL Tourist Spanish (Students gain "travel" knowledge and basic conversational skills in these oral Spanish class; meets electives credit as well as graduation requirement for SG students)

Health (HS students are required to take Health to graduate; taught by new instructor, Kevin Kelley, with a degree in Kinesiology; meets Graduation Checklist requirement)

HONORS ENG Selected Topics – Milton's Paradise Lost **NEW!** (Students will read and discuss the fundamental Christian epic poem of the English language; must have 80%+ average to gain credit; weighted grade)

HONORS GOVT: Congress: How It Worked and Why It Doesn't **NEW!** (This class will seek to understand our federal government today and why it seems broken and how to fix it by first understanding how Congress has been transformed over the past century; this is a two-day course includes an in-class day comprised of discussion/projects/debates PLUS an e-day of lectures from Hillsdale College; must have 80%+ average to gain credit; weighted grade)

HONORS TECH Yearbook Team: (Preapproval is required from Mrs. Phillips if not formerly in the class/preapproval dependent upon class size, strong computer skills, digital photography, and creativity (students will work the online); the team will brainstorm and work

on the current year's yearbook in this creative class; must have 80%+ average to gain credit; weighted grade; meets .25 HS COMP credit)

HONORS DUAL CREDIT SOCIOLOGY* NEW! - Students gain college credit in this interesting course required for most college majors and transferrable to most colleges that offers theories, research, perspectives...filtered through a Christian focus; **STUDENTS MUST REGISTER AT TVCC TO GAIN COLLEGE CREDIT—Check with the College & Career Office for details)**

Money Management for Teens, Dave Ramsey (In this Dave Ramsey curriculum, teens learn about activitgeting, personal finance, interest, taxes, credit cards, and fiscal management. Meets Graduation Credit for Money Mgt/Consumer Math; offered each semester)

New Testament Stories & Activities NEW! (Using stories and activities, learn about the lessons of the Bible (and New Testament in the Spring semester)

PE Archery* NEW! (Veteran archery team instructor and member of the PCCS coaching department, April Hoyle, teaches basics of archery, safety, and competition skills under the National Archery in Schools Program (NASP); students must have *their own competition-level Genesis compound bow of less than 20 lbs.—Walmart carries these for \$150...WALMART.COM information: "Genesis Original Bow, Model 12234, choose left or right handed, Walmart #553242036"*

PE Beginning Ballet II* NEW! (Students, boys and girls, will be introduced to classical ballet technique with an emphasis on posture, spatial awareness, and musicality; students will also learn dance class etiquette, some French terminology, 1st and 2nd position, plie, port de bras, and reverence. What to wear: 1) Girls should wear a black leotard, soft pink tights, and pink leather or canvas ballet shoes; hair should be pulled away from the face in a bun if possible; 2) Boys should wear a tight fitting white t-shirt, black dance pants or shorts, and black leather or canvas ballet shoes; sure to be a fun class!

PE Boys'/Girls' JH, JV and Varsity Team Athletics Players work on skills first until the formal season begins (Volleyball-August; Basketball-November; Baseball/Softball-March as per league rules) with after school practices required at that time; game schedules are posted on Sycamore, right sidebar, and on the CALENDAR tab; meets .5 HS PE credit)

PE Credit Alternatives for High Schoolers (Option 1-.25 PE credit will be given for students who enroll in Poetry Fitness classes held in the MPB evenings, see current schedule, must pay by the semester, school attendance policy applies); **(Option 2-**Students may apply for PE-Equivalent credit for competition sports outside of the PCCS schedule subject to certain requirements; see the College & Career Counselor for details)

PE Elementary Fitness classes (Elementary students get fit through calisthenics and outdoor fitness activities and games)

PE Holy Yoga (A favorite returns! Anyone who has taken this class knows it isn't an easy PE credit but will build strength through isometrics and weights as well as flexibility--all to contemporary Christian music; taught by student instructor and supervised by a certified Holy Yoga instructor; comfortable workout clothes permitting movement required/NO JEANS; Gain a .25 HS Graduation Checklist PE credit)

PE Karate –Christian Soldiers, White to Black Belts* (Choose the belt class that matches the student's belt level at the start of a semester (e.g., white belt = beginners). This nationally-recognized program requires Bible memory & Christian character for belt testing; CS karate uniform required). *After-school sessions required for some belts to adequately prepare for belt*

testing; a semester instructor pass-thru surcharge of \$5/week = \$80 per semester is invoiced; for those students who Belt Test, the CS Belt Testing fee is \$35.

Praise Songs! (Younger elementary students learn praise songs, a fun musical class offered by one of our new teachers)

Skills 4 Life II (Media reports that teens/young adults often lack necessary life skills to be effective adults on their own—skills that were regularly taught or learned in past decades; PCCS covers some of these essential skills in other courses such as Money Mgt Health and introduced this pilot course last semester; this semester offers this new course this semester (in a series of four courses that can be taken in any order) based upon http://www.catransitionalliance.org/docs/49-EssentialLifeSkillsforAllTeens_1029201591519.pdf Skills introduced or reinforced include how to maintain your car, basic home maintenance, how to write a cover or inquiry letter and post it, grooming and manners, basic home and maintenance skills, and more – see link).

Story Time, NEW! Students both read and tell stories as do adult leaders in this fun story telling class!

South American Culture & Activities NEW! (Students explore the life, culture, recreation, music and food children enjoy in South America)

Study Hall-Proctored (Computer access available; space limited; must work on homework or quietly read to remain in class; *sleeping or not staying academically busy will result in referral to the campus cleanup team*)

TECH Desktop Designing II (Students use a variety of formatting tools to create effective communication; some possible activities include business letter, brochures, pamphlets, advertisements; taught by our computer instructor, Mrs. Caldwell; meets .25 HS TECH credit)

TECH Digital Signage Basics & Keyboarding Skills (Students will work individually and in teams to use software to develop skills necessary to prepare, proof, edit and post digital signage on the school's LCD hallway monitors; taught by our computer instructor, Mrs. Caldwell; meets .25 HS TECH credit)

TECH Excel I (Students will learn the basics of this very useful spreadsheet; taught by our computer instructor, Mrs. Caldwell; meets .25 HS TECH credit)

TECH Internet & Digital Awareness NEW! (Students know how to use the internet and social media responsibly and safely...a class that would benefit every student; meets .25 HS TECH credit)

TECH Minecraft Teaming* NEW! (A favorite returns! But there is a limit to the class size due to room location; construction, survival, orienteering, analytical skills are required in order to make critical decisions within this virtual world; failure to abide by class rules will warrant moving the student to Study Hall and offering up the position to another student on the wait list) *\$25 server surcharge applies.*

TECH Photography* (*DIGITAL CAMERA required to enroll;* students will learn the principles behind good photography, specifically Black & White, and practice skills including editing with Photoshop)

Very Cool Stories NEW! (Through stories told by Jesus, students learn eternal truths that Jesus revealed in them...they will meet a lost and found son, a rich fool, disgruntled vineyard workers, a good Samaritan, and many other memorable characters; includes activities and crafts)
