PAYMENT OPTIONS:

'Payment in Full' Plan: A \$500 deposit is due with the signed Enrollment Contract and saves your child's space for the upcoming year. Balance must be paid by May 15 (enrollments processed after May 15 require payment in full). **The Pay in Full Discount per year:** \$350 Pay in Full Discount-Single Child per family; \$400 Pay in Full Discount-Multiple Child per family (no early bird discounts apply).

'Monthly Payment' Plan:

- Monthly rate listed above is based upon 12-month payment cycle, June – May, and includes a nominal per month "tuition insurance" fee*
- **FACTS:** All monthly payments will be collected using FACTS Tuition Management through direct withdrawal from your (1) bank account or (2) a credit card (FACTS charges a 2.85% service fee for credit card payments). FACTS assesses an annual set-up fee (*currently \$45*) which is withdrawn from your bank account when the FACTS form is processed with your financial institution.
- PCCS charges a Payment Plan Set-Up Fee of \$50 per contract, due annually upon enrollment (or re-enrollment) and payable to PCCS.
- **Late enrollees:** Plans set up after June 1st are prorated by the number of months from the date of enrollment through the month of May.

NONREFUNDABLE FEES:

Enrollment/Re-Enrollment Fees:

Annual Enrollment Fee, per New or Current Enrolling Family: \$300

New Family Enrollment Discount: 50% (\$150) with current family Referral Card (Referring family gets \$400 credit for each Referral Card for a new contracting family)

Monthly Payment Plan Set-up Fee (per family utilizing monthly payment option): \$50 (*Note: FACTS charges its own annual \$45 fee to connect with the bank*)

Other Fees: PCCS has a limited number of other fees which are not included in the quoted tuition rates, including but not limited to:

Annual State-mandated medical screening fee for new students, Primer, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 6th, 7th and 9th only: \$10

HS Science Lab/Assessment Fee (per HS Science Course/PSAT, Explorer, PLAN, C&C Aptitude; includes bus service for any off-site testing): \$120

Senior Graduation Fee: \$125 (invoiced with tuition for seniors)

Athletic Program Fees (invoiced separately by Athletics Dept. per sport): TBD per sport/team (*Electives Only Students: \$200/team sport*)

Fundraiser "Opt-Out" Fees (per semester) if family prefers not to sell: \$100 Fall Fundraiser, \$100 Spring Golf Fundraiser, \$100 Athletics Booster Fundraiser

Electives Only Students: \$90/class per semester, all grades

Semester Surcharges (See Semester Week-at-a-Glance Course Descriptions; e.g., tutoring; special fees such as 4-H, pottery, cooking; independent contractor pass-thru for music, dance, art): Due by semester Selection Sheet deadline (or if not received by deadline, surcharges added to FACTS plan)

See the current Parent-Student Handbook, Enrollment Contract, and each semester's Enrichment Course Descriptions for details about other fees (e.g., late payment fees, tardy fees, library late fees, Fast ForWord).

LINK Lab/Small Group and other Instructional Surcharges: *Small group/LINK Lab classes require payment of a LL Surcharge of \$675 per period per year (equivalent to \$19.29/wk) added to the Total Tuition rate, above.* Additional fees apply for Tutoring (\$9/session for group tutoring; \$18/session for one-on-one tutoring) and LL Core Classroom Support of \$175/class per year for LINK Lab students joining core courses such as Science/Social Studies who require modifications for instruction, assignments, quizzes, projects, and/or tests. The LINK Lab "one-on-one" instruction surcharge is determined on a case-by-case basis. In the sole discretion of PCCS, a nonrefundable deposit toward this surcharge may be assessed to reserve these services.

Bus Service: PCCS operates bus service M-Th a.m./p.m. if there enough interest. That decision is made at the August Parent Meeting as is the daily rate. Pickup/Dropoff: Terrell Library; Lake Pointe Church parking garage.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES:

Above tuition rates include all school supplies, materials and textbooks, with limited exceptions. **Not included:** Writing instruments for grades 2nd-12th; calculators for grades 4th-12th (e.g., TI-15 for 4th-6th, TI-83 for JH/HS mathematics, others as specified by teacher).

Tuition FYI: 2010: Increased only Primer, 1st and 2nd for increased expenses for those grades and comparable market rates; 2014, all grades: less than \$50/mo increase to cover medical benefits offered to full-time faculty and staff--BCBS of TX HMO in addition to the HSA plan contribution; 2017, all grades: \$50/mo increase to cover additional faculty compensation.
