TWO PAYMENT OPTIONS

NOTE: Credit Card Convenience Fee (2.85% applies for credit card payments)

Payment in Full Plan:

➤ A \$500 deposit due with Enrollment via Family ID to save your child's space for the upcoming year. Balance due by May 1 (Enrollments after 1 May require full payment).

➤ **Pay in Full Tuition Discount each year per Family***: **\$345 Pay in Full Discount-Single Child in family**
Not available for enrollments after Aug. 31.* **\$400 Pay in Full Discount-Multiple Children in family

Monthly Payment Plan:

➤ Monthly rate is based upon 12-month cycle (June–May). Plans set up after June 1st prorated by the # of months from the date of enrollment through May.

➤ **FACTS**: Monthly payments will be collected using FACTS Tuition Management through direct withdrawal from your (1) bank account or (2) a credit card (FACTS charges a 2.85% service fee for credit card payments). FACTS assesses an annual set-up fee (currently **\$45**) withdrawn from your bank account when FACTS processes with your financial institution.

➤ Annual Payment Plan Set-Up Fee of **\$50** due at time of Enrollment Contract and payable to PCCS.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

All school supplies, materials and textbooks are included with Core Tuition with these limited exceptions: Writing instruments for grades 2nd–12th; Calculators for 4th–12th (e.g., TI-15 for 4th–6th, TI-83 for JH/HS math, others as specified by teacher).

NONREFUNDABLE FEES

New Enrollment or Re-Enrollment

Annual Enrollment Fee for New or Current Enrolling Family: **\$300** (electronically via Family ID with 1.4% processing fee)
Referral Bonus:
New Family Enrollment Discount: 50% (\$150) with current family Referral Card
Referring family receives \$500 check for each new family Referral Card if new family remains enrolled for at least 1 semester

Other Fees

A limited number of other fees not included in the quoted tuition rates, include but are not limited to:

- Annual State-Mandated Medical Screening Fee (*for new students and Primer, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 6th, 7th and 9th only*): **\$10**
 - Annual DLab Licensing Fee (a pass-thru cost for Online Educational Enhancements, e.g., ALEKS Math, Dual Credit Math Lab, Membean College Bound Vocab, Elementary Big Ideas Math): 1st-5th **\$42**, 6th-12th **\$48**, Dual Credit Math 11th/12th **\$78**
 - HS Science Lab/Assessment Fee (per HS Science Course/PSAT, Explorer, PLAN, C&C Aptitude): **\$120**
 - Senior Graduation Fee: **\$175** (12th grade students only)
 - All Family Fundraiser "Opt-Out" if family *prefers not to sell*: **\$100**/Fall 5K, **\$100**/Spring Golf, **\$100**/Athletics Spring Fundraiser
- Above Fees are typically invoiced with tuition, except athletic fees which are invoiced per sport.*
- Semester Surcharges are invoiced and due the first week of each semester (See Semester Week-at-a-Glance WAAG Course Descriptions; e.g., pottery, cooking; independent contractor pass-thru for music, dance, art)
 - Electives Only Students: **\$100**/class per semester, all grades
 - Athletic Program Fees invoiced per sport: \$200/Varsity Team, \$150/JV Team, \$100/JH Team

Support Services

Launched in 2003, the PCCS Support Services program helps struggling students succeed.

Semester rates updated 2022-23

PCCS Support Services are characterized by low student/teacher ratios, specialized materials, adaptive curricula and instruction, teachers experienced in working with students with various learning challenges. Consulting and supervisory services are performed by our Support Services Specialists throughout the term such as evaluation of learning difficulties incl. prior and current records, observations, monitoring, scheduling, Personalized Education Plan (PEP) development, conferences with teachers, communications with parents and upper school students. *To cover these additional costs, PCCS Support Services necessarily includes a surcharge added to above Tuition rates on a class by class basis:*

- MI Courses: These courses incorporate Modifications to content, instructional strategies, and pace in a small class size for eligible students as supported by a PEP: **\$400**/class per semester (*\$625/class per semester for individualized one-on-one instruction with a teacher*)
- AI Courses: Courses utilize the same content as mainstream core classes with Support Services Specialists assisting teachers to incorporate various Accommodations as specified in a PEP for eligible students: **\$250**/class per semester
- Tutoring: **\$10**/group tutoring session, **\$20**/individual tutoring session (billed by the semester)
- Fast ForWord per student one-time license fee: **\$350**
