Payment in Full Plan:

- A \$500 deposit due with Enrollment to save student's space for upcoming year. Balance due by May 1 (Enrolling after May 1 requires full payment).
- Pay in Full Tuition Discount each year per Family*: \$345 Pay in Full Discount-Single Child in family *Not available for enrollments after Aug. 31. \$400 Pay in Full Discount-Multiple Children in family

Monthly Payment Plan:

- Monthly rate based upon 12-mo cycle (June–May). Plans set up after June 1st prorated by the # of months from the date of enrollment through May.
- FACTS: Monthly payments will be collected using FACTS Tuition Management through direct withdrawal from your (1) bank account or (2) a credit card (FACTS charges a 2.85% service fee for credit card payments). FACTS assesses an annual set-up fee (currently \$45) withdrawn from your bank account when FACTS processes with your financial institution.
- > Annual Payment Plan Set-Up Fee of \$95 invoiced and due upon contracting, payable to PCCS (may be added to 1st month of FACTS Plan).

SCHOOL SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, AND TEXTBOOKS ARE INCLUDED WITH TUITION

Limited exceptions: Writing instruments 2nd-12th; Calculators 4th-12th (e.g., TI-15 for 4th-6th, TI-83 for MS/HS or others as specified by teacher).

ANNUAL FAMILY ENROLLMENT FEE* - REFERRAL BONUS

Annual Family Enrollment Fee (New or Current): \$400 Referral Bonus: New Family Enrollment Discount with Referral Card is 50% (\$200).

Referring family receives \$500 check for each new family Referral Card if new family stays enrolled for at least 1 semester

OTHER FEES*

A limited number of other fees not included in the quoted tuition rates, include but are not limited to:

- MEDICAL: Annual TX-Mandated Medical Screening cost (for new students and Primer, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 6th, 7th and 9th only): \$10
- DLAB: Annual DLab per student license fee (pass-thru cost for Online Educational Enhancements "OEE," e.g., ALEKS Math, Dual Credit Math Lab, Membean Vocabulary, Elementary Big Ideas Math, Sycamore, Microsoft as applicable to each grade):
 P-5th \$45, 6th-10th \$68, 11th Reg Math+OEE \$68, 11th One Dual Credit Math+OEE \$111, 12th Reg Math+OEE \$48, 12th One Dual Credit Math+OEE \$91, Additional 11th/12th Dual Credit Math \$66
- HS SCIENCE/ASSESS ONLY: Lab/Assessment Fee (HS Science Courses/PSAT/Explorer/PLAN/C&C Aptitude): \$120

Above Fees are typically invoiced with tuition.

- ATHLETICS: Athletic Program Fees invoiced per sport: \$200/Varsity Team, \$150/JV Team, \$100/JH Team
- SELECT ELECTIVES: Semester Surcharges for a few electives to cover materials (e.g., cooking, sewing, sculpture) or independent contractor pass-thru charge. Invoiced and due 1st week of semester (See Electives Week-at-a-Glance)
- NON-PARTICIPATION FEE: Only if family opts not to participate in the primary fundraisers, including Athletics: \$200/each
- ELECTIVES-ONLY STUDENTS: \$100/class per semester (no TAPPS HS athletics), all grades

SUPPORT SERVICES

Launched in 2003, the PCCS Support Services program helps struggling students succeed. These Services are characterized by low student/teacher ratios, specialized materials, adaptive curricula, varying pace, and teachers experienced in addressing various learning challenges. Consulting and supervisory services are performed by our Support Services Specialists including evaluation of learning difficulties through prior/current records review, observations, monitoring, scheduling adjustments, Personalized Education Plan (PEP) development, teacher conferences, communications with parents and upper school students. To cover these additional costs, esp. lowers student/teacher ratio, PCCS Support Services necessarily includes a surcharge added to the above Tuition rates on a class-by-class basis:

- MI COURSES: These incorporate Modifications to content, instructional strategies, and pace in a smaller class for eligible students with a PEP: \$400/class per semester (\$625/class per semester for individualized one-on-one instruction)
- AI COURSES: Courses utilize the same content as mainstream core classes with Support Services Specialists assisting teachers to incorporate various Accommodations as specified in a PEP for eligible students: \$250/class per semester
- •TUTORING*: \$10/group tutoring session, \$20/individual tutoring session (billed by the semester)
- ONLINE INTERVENTIONS*: Fast ForWord or Nessie Reading per student license fee/each: \$350
